**Plantation Campaign 2022**

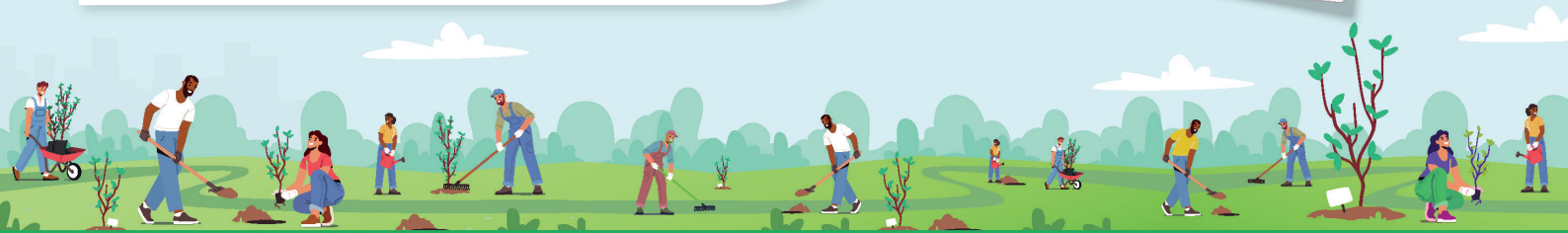


“Oman Tree Day” which falls on 31st October of each year as an affirmation to the importance of different kinds of trees in Oman.

As part of PDO's participation in Khareef Salalah, PDO in collaboration with the Environment Authority in Dhofar Governorate and Dhofar Municipality, has initiated a campaign to plant 5,500 native trees in Sahal Hamran. This campaign commenced on (7 August) and continued for five days. The objective of the campaign was to increase the green cover in the Governorate and contribute to the national initiative of planting 10 million trees. The campaign included planting various types of native trees, such as Subar, Sidr trees and Arabian combs.



PDO has also partnered with Dhofar Municipality to conduct multiple clean up campaigns across Salalah under the umbrella of #Better\_than\_it\_was. The clean-up campaigns commenced on (6 August) and will continue until (2 September). This comes as part of PDO's Estidama (sustainability) campaign's efforts towards a greener Oman.
