
# MR. MUSLEH's NEWS

We hope that you will enjoy our new method of summarising the lessons so that we can all better learn from the injuries and losses we have incurred from our HSE incidents.




### **PDO** incidents

- Pipe crushed his finger
- Technician loses finger

# Pipe crushed his finger

A Derrickman fixed a small leak in a joint between a pipe and the flow line connected to the BOP. He chose to check the size of the gap in the joint by sticking in his finger. Vibrations from the BOP caused the joint to move, the gap closed and his index finger was crushed.





### Technician loses finger

A Technician manually aligned a corrosive insertion ring while instructing the Assistant Driller to lower the tubing hanger. As the hanger was lowered he trapped his right index finger and he instinctively pulled out his finger causing its amputation.







### His leg broke from falling panel

GRC panels were unloaded from a trailer and placed on an A-frame. A panel toppled forward as the crew tried to release the cranes sling. Unable to hold the weight a worker was hit on his shoulder and then it crushed his leg resulting in severe pain from a fracture.




### Crane injures Crane operator

A wire rope had come off a cranes boom sheave and jammed. The crane operator lowered the boom leaving the hook block suspended from the ground. He pulled on the wire rope freeing it from the assembly but the hook block came free and pulled his right hand between the block and wire line crushing two fingers.

A Derrickman was picking up slips along with two floor men when he leant his right hand on the tongs for support. The tongs jaws closed on his hand crushing and fracturing his right thumb.

A roustabout tried to help a two man crew place the bit breaker tool into the slots on the rotary table. The tool crushed his hand against the rotary table fracturing his finger and causing a deep cut that needed eight stitches.
