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

Finger pulled between belts

An Electrician checking the belt tension on the wash gun unit. The mechanic, leaning on the unit caught the start button unintentionally; the rotary belt started to spin and pulled the electrician's fingers into the pulley. Link





Water breaks nose While on a team building day an employee suffers a broken nose when he fell off a bananna boat into the sea. Link





Choke line hose drops on Derrick mans foot

When they found the choke line hose (CLH) was stuck, the Night Tool Pusher instructed the floor man to collect a pry bar. While waiting for the pry bar, the derrick man tried to release the CLH, using a sledge hammer. Result broken foot. Link





Driller falls 3.5m

During Hoist Rig down the shade tilted when it was being lifted by a forklift knocking the driller off balance and falling from a height of 3.5 meters to the ground.







Mechanic crushed by vehicle

Mechanics were working in the vehicle workshop area, upon completion of the job, the vehicle was started from the outside whilst still in geardriving forward crushing the second mechanic who was standing in front of the vehicle and in the "line of fire". Link





Unauthorised journey kills

Supervisor

The driver had departed on a unauthorised journey from Nimr prior to working hours and without a journey plan. Link





Safety guard left open

Trainee Night Tool Pusher was standing on top of the mud pump while it was running and the piston cover was open, he slipped, lost his balance and his foot went inside resulting in a fracture to his right foot. Link





Fall from the stair

Stepping down diagonally from the landing, and tripping on the raised edge of the walkway and fell on his right hip.

Technician falls backwards

Whilst loosening nuts on a flange using a ring spanner it slipped off the nut as the fabricator applied force to it, causing him to loose balance and fall to the ground fracturing his left wrist and right elbow. Link





Stored Energy breaks bone

The roustabout attached the wire rope sling to the Top-drive but wasn't aware that it was twisted (and had stored energy), as he pulled the wire rope sling, the sling unwound and struck his hand fracturing a bone. Link





Supervisor rolls over

A supervisor was driving to Qarn Alam from Muscat in a Company vehicle. During the journey he drifted off the road and oversteered in an attempt to regain control. The vehicle rolled over multiple times causing the drivers head to hit the side window frame resulting in his death. Link
