It is also important to have an efficient and effective assurance programme to evaluate the appropriateness and readiness of our controls.

I seek your support and commitment to drive simplicity, ensuring we fully understand what we ask of our frontline, and your leadership and intervention in championing our Golden Rules and Life Saving Rules. Please also ensure we adhere to prescribed medical and Fitness to Work requirements to support delivery of our duties. Let us all work together to make "Goal Zero" a reality.
