Over Head Lines (OHL) and Kicker Boards



During a recent Rig Move, several kicker board (KB) lines were lifted by crane, tele-handler (man riding basket) and persons climbing on the monkey board to lift the line clear of the rig mast.

- Do <u>not</u> lift Kicker Board lines
- Notify Electrical department when lines are too low

Safety Alert

Mr. Musleh asks the questions of can it happen to you?

- 1. Are the correct dimensions (width, height, length, weight) marked on equipment and briefed to drivers?
- 2. Is the height of the Rig confirmed during the Pre Rig Move Meetings?
- 3. Are all kicker boards and OHL measured and recorded during the Route Survey?
- 4. Do you ensure the DSV or Tool Pusher present during Route Surveys?
- 5. Do you report inaccuracies of kicker board heights?
- 6. Are drivers reminded of overhead power lines during TBT's?
- 7. Do you ensure you adhere to the requirements of SP-1242?
