What happened?

Three incidents occurred with the same type of crane (Hydra crane).
One of them caused a fatality in Ghala industrial area (not PDO).

Why it happened?

- Crane poor stability and
- Lack in safety features.

Lifting Equipment



Lesson learned:

- Ensure all cranes are complying with international standards EN 7127-2-3 and EN 13000 or equivalent.
- Ensure all lifting equipment meet PDO procedure PR-1708/09 requirements.
- Ensure all lifting equipment is certified by approved lifting inspection agencies.

Recommendation:

•Hydra crane not to be used in all PDO area and its contractor's premises for PDO operations.



Safety Alert

Mr. Musleh asks the questions of can it happen to you?

- 1. Do you make sure the equipment being used has been tested and is fit for use?
- 2. Do you make sure the equipment and attachments are secure and valid 3rd party certificates are in date?
- 3. Do you ensure that the lift plan and the risk assessment are in place?
- 4. Do you ensure the work area is clear before carrying out lifting operations?
- 5. Do you ensure that people are competent for the job?
