




#### Mr. Musleh's News

**Boom Drops** A Mechanical crew were engaged in lifting operation while moving the load the lifting belt slipped out of the hook causing one side of the boom to drop.







standing beneath.






Struck by?

#### Tipper tips over

An articulated tipper while unloading soil by lifting the hydraulic cylinder ram, due to th uneven surface condition and wet soil accumulated on the righ side top end, the tipper tipped over to its right. View





## <u>Tanker tips over</u> Whilst negotiating a left hand turn at a

T-junction the tanker tipped over on to it's passenger side. landing on 2 x pipe lines. View



#### Rollover 2

When the driver swerved to the left to avoid hitting a sand pile, he lost control of the vehicle and rollover. **View** 





#### **Spot the Camels**

from Marmul to Nimr field blacktop road, before reaching Amal field Intersection, they hit two camels.

#### Pinch points

To release a jammed rope while the hook block was unsupported, the wire-rope suddenly released !!! <u>View</u>





#### **Mooring line fails**

During some rough weather one of the two mooring lines holding the maintenance barge to the mooring buoy failed. View

Rollover 3
As there were road blockades the driver decided to take the left shoulder to by pass them. While he was trying to re-enter to the black top, he over steered to the right and lost control resulting in a S" pattern.




Wrong overtake
