This month Mr. Musleh will summarise the learning's from incidents of the Lost Time Injuries (LTIs) , High Potential (HiPos) and High Value Learnings (HvI) that have occurred during the  $3^{\rm rd}$  and  $4^{\rm th}$  quarters of 2020. You can browse the incidents in the newsletter which have been designed to be read in an easy to digest format and delve deeper into the learning's if you think the incident or learning is relevant to you.



LTI14 Die broke off & Dropped

While removing the manual tong dies, one die was stuck and the floorman used chisel with chisel holder to hammer the dies. While hammering, a small fragment from the die broke off and hit the floorman... <u>View</u>





LTI#15 Roustabout Fell
Down

A Roustabout lost his balance while standing on the pipe ram BOP to shake the flexible hose joint of the flowline. The flowline came out from the vent line end and swung in the direction of the Roustabout and fell down approx. 0.5 m..





LTI#16 Groin Area Injury
A Carpenter was working
in the kitchen to install
aluminum frame in the
kitchen. While cutting
through the aluminum
angle bar, grinder lost
contact with the
aluminum piece and it
came in contact with his
genital area..







LTI#18 Felt Dizzy & Slipped

A carpenter felt dizzy while working on a scaffold platform of height 1.8 meters and while coming down he slipped from the last few rungs of the ladder. **View** 



#### LTI#24 Fingers Got <u>Pinched</u>

While floorman was aligning the bowl housing, the Fishing Engineer stepped forward to align the bo housing by putting in between the bowl housing and the safety floor. Then, he left hand fingers were pinched. View





#### LTI#20 Graded road MVI

While a driver was driving on graded road, an oncoming vehicle created a dust cloud, this obscured the driver's vision and his vehicle drove into and over the sand dune, this caused the vehicle to jump and jerk violently. View



#### HIPO#50 Vehicle Rolled

<u>Over</u>


1ton pick-up while taking a turn from the blacktop towards the A-Station road was hit by a third-party private vehicle which was overtaking from the left side of the pick-up. View





LTI#22 Trapped Finger

While attempting to align sucker rod BOP flange over the X-mas tree, Floorman placed his hand underneath an shifted downwards, then his hand ring finger got caught. View



#### HIPO#51 Dropped Drill

**Pipe** 

Drill pipe joint was hanged up with power swivel for soft break out, then while lowering DP to lay down, drill pipe with FOSV disengaged and dropped through the V-door and rested on the ground.







LTI#23 Twisted <u>Ankle</u>


During BOP drill, while coming down from rig floor to Natih manifold through the stair, Derrick man right ankle twisted at the ground level. <u>View</u>



#### HIPO#52 Released Nitrogen Gas

The Oxygen Reduction gas based fire suppression system, released Nitrogen gas inside the data center with big burst causing multiple damage to ceiling and data storage equipment. The fire tender was called View







HIPO#53 Dropped
Wrench
During the replacement
of wash pipe wrench,

the wrench slipped from wash pipe hammer union and came off due to the failure of the secondary retention and fell on the rig floor inside the controlled red zone.





HIPO#57 Monkey Board Hits DM

While pulling out of hole 4" heavy weight drill pipe, travelling block touched on the drill pipe stand when the Driller lowered the traveling block before the DM moves the drill pipe stand but he tripped whilst moving away.







HIPO#54 Damaged LV Cable

Crew while doing the backfilling activity using a backhoe loader, the loader tooth struck and damaged a live LV Cable feeding supply to well.



#### HIPO#59 Tanker Hits Cargo Vehicle

A cargo vehicle on route to Izz loaded with 20t of chemical bags was involved in a motor vehicle incident while travelling on a dual carriage way. A water tanker entered the road into the path of the cargo vehicle.








HIPO#55 Knocked Kicker Board

Whilst moving a rig convoy, the truck with the mast carrier was passing under the overhead line. The mast struck the 2<sup>nd</sup> kicker board, pulling the kicker board line and one of the goal posts down.

HIPO#60 Dropped
Travelling Block

While the block descended and rested on the rig floor, the fast line got removed from the fast line clamp and travelled through the fast line sheave and dropped to the rig floor.





HIPO#56 Tipper Tips
A tipper tipped over
while coming from

Fayyad-01 to Bahja waste yard. the driver lost control over the vehicle and moved a bit to right side. The right side tyres entered into soft sand.

HIPO#61 Roustabout

<u>Fell Down</u> The Roustabout was

hammering on the direction of purlins to the small pipe diameter. On the 4th attempt, the Roustabout lost balance and fell on the right side over the handrail.


HIPO#62 Damaged Pole
While a civil crew was
removing a temporarily
constructed ramp, the
wheel loader hit a 33KV
I12 pole as it was
reversing. The pole and
the conductor were
damaged..

HIPO#77 Dropped Coil
Tubing
An injector head was
lifted on air to remove
the riser. While the
injector was suspended
on air, Coiled Tubing
pipe came off the
injector goose neck and
fall on the ground..
View



HIPO#63 Drill Pipe Slips
The 13th joint was
hanging from the 2 7/8"
slip type B&V Elevator
in order to make-up
with power tong. The
drill pipe suddenly
slipped through the
elevator and fell down
to the ground..



HVL#18 Dropped SR
Elevator
During pulling out of hole sucker rod, the Derrickman and Floorman engaged the power tong to break up the lower joint. While engaging, the upper end of the SR started swinging and led the

upper elevator to fall

down.. View





HIPO#64 Fish Slips Fell Down

While running in hole 13-3/8" shoe track, the driller suspected that the edge of float shoe was hooked up inside conductor shoe. As the casing shoe was coming through the slips it caught slip segment.







HVL#19 Drill Pipe Joint
Fell Down
During lay down DR

During lay down DP from rig floor to catwalk by using mobile crane and two web slings the lifted pipe was not in balance position which led web sling to slip.. View





HIPO#68 Welding without Following PTW

A small leak at the base of the reserve tank was discovered by the crew that was causing a small flow of water with oil mix out onto the sand. It was decided to have the welder to make a temporary repair on the tank... View





LTI#25 Landing Joint Drops

Landing joint rolled off the catwalk and fell on the right foot of the Slick line Assistant Operator who was standing near the catwalk to remove the hose.. View






LTI#26 Fingers Got

While securing upper

LTI#27 Face Strike
A rigger was
standing in between
the stack of moving
reels at the trailer, as
he instructed the
driver to stop,
unsecured rotating
reels came out of
their connections
and strike the rigger
on his face..



HIPO#72 Fire at
A temple
while walking
towards the
common ablution
heard smoke
detector alarm and
saw smoke coming
out from the
Temple..

HIPO#66 Released
Brine Fluid
While the crew were
disconnecting Gun 3 a
and Gun 4, trapped
pressure released oil
with brine splash to
floor man and SIB
member..
View





HIPO#73 Dropped
Chemical Bag
While lifting the
chemical bag by using 4
leg chemical Bag lifter,
crane operator started
lifting the bag towards
the hopper. Once the
bag reached beside the
hopper its fell down
and landed at the
mixing platform.. View





HIPO#67 Dropped
Unsecured Travelling
Block
While the driller was

While the driller was lowering the (5 ton) traveling block from a height of 6 mtr. to rig floor level, the fast line disconnected from the clamp and came down to the rig floor from the fast line sheave.. <u>View</u>





HIPO#74 Dropped
Lower Tie Back
While back reaming on
section with erratic
torque and vibration, a
piece from the lower
tie back broke and
dropped from the mast
beam from height of 3
meters, weighing 18 Kg
landing on the rig floor...




#### HIPO#75 Motor Vehicle Incident (MVI)
