




PDO 2006 HSE Performance



- Road traffic accidents contributed substantially > 90%
- Lowest scores in 2002 Deaths/BillionKM rate getting worse in recent years
 - Urgent case for change!

- 2 persons dead every minute











Road traffic injury even death is the price to be paid for achieving mobility and economic development.





Causes of Oman Road Accidents




Traffic accidents on the Sultanate of Oman roads during 2005 were 9,247 accidents as follows:

If PDO Changes the Hearts & Minds of...

- If PDO changes the Hearts & Minds of 8000 employees and contractors
- If each employee/contractor changes the Hearts & Minds of 10 family members/relatives
 → 80,000
- If they change the Hearts & Minds of 10 friends
 → 800,000
- If they change the Hearts of Minds of another 4 friends → 3,200,000
- All Oman residents & some visitors will have changed!
 A safe country to live, work, drive and walk.



How Are We Doing in 2007?

- Better HSE record than 2006
 - Oman: 253 deaths, 3011 injuries in 4035
 crashes (Jan. 1 to May 25)
 DDO: 0 fetality, 271 TL (Jan. 1 to June 1)
 - PDO: 0 fatality, 27 LTI (Jan. 1 to June 1)
- Make it even better
