

Non Compliance – Oil Spills

1. Timely notification, reporting and clean up of leaks.

- In order to comply with the law, the following shall be done:
 1. All major leaks (i.e. spills $\geq 10\text{m}^3$ gross) shall be reported in PIM within 24 hrs. Other pin hole leaks to be reported immediately in PIM.
 2. Site clean up shall be initiated immediately.

Non Compliance – Disposal of raw sewage

1. Overflow or disposal of raw sewage in the desert or open pits (lagoons) posing a health & environmental risks to people and environment.
 - In order to comply with the law, the following shall be done:
 1. All sewage should be stored in holding tanks and regularly transported to STPs with consignment notes.
 2. Regular inspection of holding tanks capacity and sewage pipes.

Non Compliance – Mixing of Hazardous & Non-Hazardous waste

1. Mixing of Hazardous & Non-Hazardous waste streams

- In order to comply with the law, hazardous and non-hazardous waste streams should be segregated and separate skips used
